### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF TOURS:**

#### **CITY TOUR (4 HOURS)**

See the best of Panama City in a few hours. Take a tour of the New Town, with its important banking and commercial center. We proceed to the Casco Viejo; a colonial area that is the second oldest city of Panama, which is distinguished by its unique architecture with Spanish and French influence. We will visit the Plaza de Francia, Paseo Esteban Huertas, the Plaza Bolivar, Plaza de la Catedral, San Jose Church, Altar de Oro, and parks and other attractions in the area. Then, we will proceed with a panoramic tour of our Amador Causeway and its group of island and cruise port. After that we will go to the Miraflores Lock and its visitor center. This lock, is the most important of the Panama Canal. OUTPUT: in the morning or afternoon.

#### **CITY TOUR (8 HOURS)**

Start in the morning visiting the ruins of Panama Viejo, the capital of Castilla de Oro, and operations center for the conquest of South America. This historical city dates back to the sixteenth century and was destroyed by pirate Henry Morgan in 1671. Then, we will tour the New Town, with its important banking and commercial center. We proceed to the Casco Viejo; a colonial area that is the second oldest city of Panama, which is distinguished by its unique architecture with Spanish and French influence. We will visit the Plaza de Francia, Paseo Esteban Huertas, the Plaza Bolivar, Plaza de la Catedral, Plaza Herrera, San Jose Church, Altar de Oro, National Theatre and other parks and attractions. In addition, you can visit the Canal Museum and learn about its history. We will have lunch around "Casco Viejo" and then, we will continue with our tour of Calzada de Amador Causeway, and its group of islands and cruise port. We will stop at the Balboa handicraft market where you can purchase at great prices, molas, tagua work, the famous "Panama Hat", the Bugle Nghobe costumes and other curiosities of our different ethnicities. Hence, we will raise our Ancon hill, where you can enjoy the best view of the city and the Panama Canal. Depending on the time of the ships, we will visit the Miraflores Locks and the visitor center before or after the "Causeway" and the Old Quartier. Miraflores is the most important locks of the Panama Canal.



## **TOUR PORTOBELO BY TRAIN**

Begin your day at 07:00a.m. with a journey on the historic original train from Panama City to Colon. The train journey, takes about 1 hour, taking you through the jungle and along the Panama Canal, the National Park Rainforest. Sovereignty to help build the Canal, in 1880 the French company acquired the Panama Canal railway line.

In our tour of Portobelo, you can see the cannons that still show the importance of defense. Portobelo, was the target of several attacks by pirates, including Henry Morgan. Will visit all the ruins of the colonial port, the customs office where the treasures were stored, and the Portobelo church, where lies the miraculous Black Christ.

**Important Note: This tour operates only Monday through Friday.**

**Tour includes:** Transfer from the Hotel – Train Station, one way by train from Panama to Colon, Portobelo visit, lunch and refreshments, specialized guide, transfer back to the hotel from Colon private transportation company.

## **VALLE DE ANTON TOUR**

Leaving Panama at 9:00 am, travel to the central provinces, the Valle de Anton, is 600 feet above sea level. El Valle de Anton, is an ancient caldera of an extinct volcano, whose slopes are covered with tropical rain forests that are traversed by rivers and stunning waterfalls. The most famous to see is the Chorro Del Macho, enjoy a short hike through dense rain forest, while enjoying the lush vegetation and abundance of birds and other animals in their natural habitat. The most famous mountain in India is asleep, which has led writers to immortalize a legend of the colonial era.

Visit the zoo and botanical garden El Nispero, home to many endemic and endangered, and the Valley Museum, which exhibits pre-Columbian art and colonial relics in the area. We'll see square trees and petroglyphs, anthropomorphic images and symbols that have not yet been deciphered by archaeologists. Visit the craft market, where you can get from natural wild orchids, to figures carved in stone by local people. Back to town after lunch.

**Tour includes:** transportation, snacks, lunch, guide, entrance to the Zoo, Hot Springs and Botanical Garden.

## **TOUR COMUNIDAD EMBERRA**

This adventure takes us to the indigenous community in the Chagres National Park. We will get to know the culture of the Embera Indians and witness their artisans and enjoy the knowledge of botanical plants. Their cultural dances and music will take you back centuries. If you would like you can also paint your body as they do with the fruit known as Jagua.

We can also observe the grand variety of birds found in these areas. Walk in the jungle, explore waterfalls and learn from a magical culture, all this on just one day.

## **PARTIAL TRANSIT PANAMA CANAL**
