

## **EXCURSIONS THAT CAN BE BOOKED:**

### **TOUR OF THE HISTORIC PART OF THE CITY WITH A VISIT TO MONSERRATE:**

A Panoramic tour of the historical sector of the city, visiting the Colon Theatre, The San Carlos Palace where the chancellery is situated, The San Ignacio Church, The Nariño Presidential Palace, The Bolivar Square, The Capitol Building, The Mayor's office and the Cathedral. We will also visit the famous Gold Museum. Then we will visit the Monserrate Sanctuary in the Cable Car, situated at 3152 meters above sea level. From here you can appreciate a fantastic view of the city. On Monday's the Gold Museum is closed, and will therefore be replaced by the Botero Exposition. on Tuesday's the Botero Exposition is closed. Includes refreshments.

### **RELIGIOUS TOUR:**

### **TOUR OF ZIPAQUIRA & SALT CATHEDRAL: (lunch included)**

Situated in the plains of Bogota, the Salt Cathedral of Zipaquira is a work of art, built in the tunnels of a mine that is 180 meters deep and it is considered one of the first wonders of Colombia.

### **TOUR OF THE SALT CATHEDRAL OF ZIPAQUIRA & GUATAVITA. (lunch included)**

We depart for the town of La Calera from where you can appreciate a beautiful view of Bogota. Afterwards we continue to the town of Sesquile where we will take an ecological walk to admire the most celebrated and sacred lagoons of pre-Colombian times, where the legendary Rito de El Dorado was staged. We then continue to Zipaquira, where we will have lunch and visit the Salt Cathedral. Tour is valid from Tuesday to Sunday.

### **COFFEE TOUR FUSAGASUGÁ. (lunch included)**

One hour from Bogota on the Panamerican highway lies the town of Fusagasugá, where you will visit the Coloma Hacienda, a typical coffee plantation that preserves the historical tradition of once being the most important coffee producing area in the country. Here it is possible to see different species of coffee, beautiful gardens, and experience the whole process from planting, selecting, ripening, right up to roasting of the coffee beans. The gardens are surrounded by bromeliads, orchids in their natural state and many plants and trees of diverse species. You can also peruse the town's market square where you will find many exotic fruits and flowers. Lunch will be served in one of the most traditional restaurants of the region, recognized for its "rabbit al gratin"
