SANTO DOMINGO FULL DAY

Meet the capital Santo Domingo, which is very essential for the country. Here began the history of America. It is a cosmopolitan, vibrant, full of a deep historical past associated with the conquest of the Americas. Located south of the island, the city is washed by the waves and breezes of the Caribbean Sea.

The Colonial Zone, declared a Common Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO, including the oldest constructions created by the Spaniards; administrative offices as the first or the first cathedral in the New World.

You will visit a lot of important monuments and museums in the area, as well as the main streets. You will have a buffet lunch including 1 drink. After lunch you have some free time for shopping.

SAONA ISLAND

Saona has become through the years, the number 1 tour of the Dominican Republic. An unforgettable experience that combines the beauty of the National Park of the east with the tranquility of the Caribbean Sea.

After a tour in an air-conditioned bus to the beach of Bayahibe, a former fishing village, you will board a large catamaran and sail along the coast towards Saona. On the catamaran open bar is included. Once you arrive at Saona, you can relax, play a game of volleyball or walk along the island. Your buffet will be waiting (rice, chicken and fish, pasta salad, green salad, fruit and coffee), drink included (rum, beer, water, soft drinks).

On the return you will sail to the natural swimming pools, sandbars where the water comes to the waist, a sanctuary of starfish where you can swim with them. You will continue your journey back, but not before making a stop at the Canal Catuano, where you will have a panoramic view of mangroves, exuberant vegetations that grows exclusively in salt water.
