

DAILY PROGRAM

Day 1	<p>New York</p> <p>Arrival transfer from Airport to Hotel in private motor coach with English speaking guide.</p> <p>Welcome to the world-famous Big Apple"! New York City is the ultimate cosmopolitan city in the world; there is lower Manhattan's Chinatown and Little Italy, the traditionally Jewish Lower East Side, the more artsy concentrations of SoHo, TriBeCa, and the East and West Villages. Of course, there is the celebrated architecture of corporate Manhattan, with the skyscrapers in downtown and midtown forming the most unforgettable images. Tonight, perhaps visit Times Square, named after the New York Times; this is a vibrant, neon-lit area in the heart of the Theater District. Here you will find megastores and themed restaurants to please all tastes and budgets.</p> <p>A 2 hour Night tour with guide in private motor coach is included.</p>
Day 2	<p>New York</p> <p>Today clients enjoy a 8 hour city tour in a private motor coach with an English</p>

	speaking guide.
Day 3	<p>New York- Boston- Danvers</p> <p>Clients start their over the road tour in private motor coach and English speaking guide.</p> <p>First stop is Boston where the guests enjoy a city tour upon arrival.</p> <p>A guided tour of historic Boston will include some of the major area attractions such as Faneuil Hall, Old North Church, Paul revere’s House, U.S.S. Constitution Memorial, Boston Commons, Statehouse, Beacon Hill, Bunker Hill Monument.</p> <p>Continue to Danvers for overnight.</p>
Day 4	<p>Danvers- Portland</p> <p>To the north is the historic town of Gloucester, America’s oldest seaport and site of the epic movie The Perfect Storm. Continuing up the coast we stop in Rockport. The town of Rockport is well-loved by visitors and residents alike for its breath-taking setting in the heart of mid-coast Maine. Continues on to the quaint New England resort town of Kennebunkport. The town is home to the Bush Compound in Walker’s Point where the former presidential family retreats for some rest and relaxation. In the afternoon, continue to Portland for a one night stay. Stopping along the way at picturesque Portland Head Light, it is one of the most popular and photographed lighthouses in the country because of its beauty and spectacular views, history and literary associations.</p>
Day 5	<p>Portland- Quebec</p> <p>Most of the day will be spent on a scenic drive to Quebec City, through small towns and cross the U.S. / Canadian Border to enter Canada by late afternoon. We drive the Old Canada Road Scenic Byway, this scenic segment of Route 201 winds alongside the Kennebec River, Wyman Lake, and the Dead River. The gateway between Quebec and Maine is Jackman, named after Captain James Jackman who was hired by the state to complete construction of a road to Canada, in the 1930s. Jackman, Maine is part of the Moose River Valley, nestled in between mountains to the North and South and surrounded by forests, wildlife, streams, and lakes. After crossing the boarder we will continue to Quebec City for a two night stay.</p>
Day 6	<p>Quebec</p> <p>Quebec is a walled city, one of the oldest in North America, capital of its province and a bastion of French Canadian culture. In 1985, its Old Town was dubbed a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Our tour through Old Québec, the Plains of Abraham and the fortified city including the Citadelle and the Château Frontenac, the Place-Royale will take most of the morning. There will be free time for a lunch</p>

	on own and some trendy shopping.
Day 7	<p>Quebec- Montreal</p> <p>Leaving Quebec we head to Montreal, an edgy, cosmopolitan city with a dash of European flair. It is considered by some to be the cultural capital of Canada. Upon arrival in the city we will visit the Notre-Dame Basilica in the historic district of Old Montreal. Afterwards there is time for lunch on own before a short city tour of the highlights of Montreal's landmarks including Old Montreal, the oldest area of the city with a few remains dating back to New France, and the Olympic Park. The rest of the day is free to explore the city at leisure</p>
Day 8	<p>Montreal- 1000 Islands Cruise- Toronto</p> <p>Gananoque is our next destination for a boat cruise through the scenic bays, channels and passages of the 1000 Islands; these beautiful islands are said to be the remains of mountains stripped of their tops by glaciers.</p> <p>Continuing to Toronto, the most populous city in Canada and the most multicultural diverse city in the world: over 140 languages are spoken. The flavors, aromas, sights and sounds of almost every nation converge peacefully in the streets of Toronto's many neighborhoods: microcosms of culture thriving in a somewhat hazy 'bigger picture' that proud locals defend regardless. Early in the evening visit CN tower, the Glass Floor Level offers a great view 1,122 foot (342 meters) down for those who are not afraid of heights. There will be free time at leisure to enjoy shops, cafes' and quaint parks.</p>
Day 9	<p>Toronto- Niagara Falls- Finger Lakes Area</p> <p>The morning starts with a trip to Niagara Falls one of the world's most breathtaking natural wonders to experience these magnificent falls up-close with a boat tour.</p> <p>After that continue the tour to Finger Lakes area, a region of New York State. It's named for its series of long, thin lakes, and known for its vineyards.</p>
Day 10	<p>Finger Lakes Area- New York</p> <p>Final drive from Finger Lakes to New York. En route we will make a stop at a shopping mall.</p> <p>In NYC, guests can enjoy their last afternoon / evening at leisure and explore the city on own.</p>
Day 11	<p>New York- Departure</p> <p>Pick up from hotel in private motor coach and English speaking guide for transfer to airport.</p>
